

Kaisho Martial Arts

Codes of conduct for Parents and Carers

All Parents / Carers must:

- Complete and return the Registration, Medical and Consent Form pertaining to your child's participation with Kaisho Martial Arts
- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in their martial arts
- Do not place your child under pressure or push them into taking part in martial arts if they do not want to do.
- Drop off and collect your child punctually before and after their training sessions
- Ensure your child has their clean GI and belt for every training session
- Detail any relevant medical concerns or conditions pertaining to their child on the registration/consent form. Any changes in the state of the child's health should be reported to the club / instructor prior to the activity.
- Encourage your child to abide by the club rules, and teach them that they can only do their best.
- Ensure that your child understands their code of conduct.
- Behave responsibly if staying at the training session showing respect to all other parent / carers, students and instructors
- Ensure your child plus adequate water to drink during the training session.
- Accept the instructor's judgment with regards to the training and grading eligibility
- Promote that your child's participation in martial arts should be for fun but also respect and self defence.
- Comply with all Health and Safety regulations

All Parent / Carers must NOT:

- Show any disrespect toward any other instructor, volunteer, student or parent/carer
- Arrive to any training session under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Discriminate between any member of the club or their parents/carers for any reason whatsoever.
- Use bad language during any training session, no matter whether they are young or adult students.
- Unnecessarily interfere with or disrupt the training sessions
- Speak loudly or allow younger sibling to run around the dojo during training sessions as this causes a distraction to both the instructor and the students.
- Take photos or videos of any student or publish any images on social media without prior consent of all parents /carers in the image plus the club officials
- Use any Kaisho social media to promote any other businesses or products.
